MCERTS Inspectors – attendance on site

MCERTS Inspectors are reminded that they are required to attend each site inspected. This is an essential element of the MCERTS scheme. The MCERTS Inspection body will require evidence of attendance on site.

Minimum Requirements for the Self-Monitoring of Effluent Flow, Version 3.3, September 2010, Clause 3.3.4 states.....

“It is not acceptable for an MCERTS Inspector to simply conduct a desk review of an inspection carried out by an Assistant Inspector. The MCERTS Inspector must visit the site.”

Furthermore, it is acceptable for individuals not appointed as MCERTS Inspectors or Assistant Inspectors [e.g. Trainees] to attend site and to assist with the inspection process provided they are accompanied and supervised by an MCERTS Inspector.
